RE: Information in MLS compilations of current listings

Dear Mr. Lowenthal:

I respectfully advise that your concerns about information in MLS compilations were discussed at length during the recent March 2-3, 2003 meeting of the Interpretations and Procedures Subcommittee of the National Association's Professional Standards Committee.

It was the conclusion of the Subcommittee that those concerns will be best addressed under Article 2 of the Code of Ethics. The Subcommittee requested staff to develop a proposed case interpretation making the point that inclusion of deceptive or misleading information in MLS compilations potentially violates Article 2. The draft case will be considered at the Subcommittee's next meeting and, if found acceptable, will be recommended to the Professional Standards Committee for adoption at the 2003 Convention

The Subcommittee also asked that I share their sincere appreciation for your efforts in bringing this issue to their attention.
